Buying a living Christmas tree is a popular choice for green consumers, but each tree is unique and requires special care. RCBC's here to provide you with some tips!



01 | PICKING THE RIGHT TREE



Go Native - Pick a tree adapted to local conditions.



Be Gentle - Trees are living things! Burlapped trees should be picked up by their root balls or rolled along the ground, never by their stems.





02 | TREE TENDING TIPS



Condition - Leave it upright in an unheated garage for a few days.

Pick The Right Spot - Place inside in a cool



location away from direct sunlight or heat sources like stoves, fireplaces, and vents.



Water Sparingly - Living trees don't need as much water as cut ones, but the roots and soil should be kept moist. Place the tree inside a bucket or a large pan to prevent water staining.





03 | CONSIDER TREE RENTALS



Want to a live tree but don't have a green thumb? Consider a Christmas tree rental - a service that's growing in popularity.
